



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

ROAD CLOSURE ALONG FLORAL AVENUE IN FRESNO COUNTY

FRESNO COUNTY, CALIF. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces a full road closure along Floral Avenue, between Cedar and Chestnut avenues in Fresno County for construction of a high-speed rail overcrossing. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, June 19, 2023 and will continue through December 2024.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

CLOSURE AND DETOUR INFORMATION:

Road closure along Floral Avenue, between Cedar and Chestnut avenues in Fresno County for construction of a high-speed rail overcrossing.

Work is scheduled to begin Monday, June 19, 2023 and will continue through December 2024.

EASTBOUND TRAFFIC

- Traffic going eastbound on Floral Avenue will be detoured south on Cedar Avenue, east on Nebraska Avenue, north on Chestnut

Avenue, then east on Floral Avenue.

WESTBOUND TRAFFIC

- Traffic going westbound on Floral Avenue will be detoured south on Chestnut Avenue, west on Nebraska Avenue, north on Cedar Avenue, then west on Floral Avenue.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all property and business owners.
